

DRAGAN ŠEVO

Dragan Ševo se 2008. godine vratio sa svojom petočlanom porodicom u Bukovaču kod Bosanskog Petrovca. Nezaposlen je i izdržava se od poljoprivredne proizvodnje. Njegov glavni izvor prihoda je prodaja voća i mliječnih proizvoda.

Dragan je 2010. godine bio korisnik UNHCR-ovog projekta koji je implementirao Hilfswerk Austria International (HWA). Dodijeljeno mu je 55 kg heljde u sjemenu za pola hektara zemljišta a prvi žetva je donijela oko 1000 kg heljde. Od tog prinosa on je ponovo heljdom zasijao jedan hektar zemljišta, a ostatak je prodao u vidu sjemena i brašna. Prodaja heljdinog brašna je Dragalu donijela zaradu i pomogla izdržavanje njegove porodice. Od svih općina u Bosni i Hercegovini, Bosanski Petrovac u 2010. godini imao najveću površinu poljoprivrednog zemljišta zasijanog heljdom.

Tokom prodajne izložbe upriličene za Svjetski dan izbjeglica, Dragan Ševo će izložiti širok spekter brašna mljevenog u mlinu, pogodnog za pravljenje pure i pogače, u pakovanja od jednog kilograma. Gotovi proizvodi kao što su kolači i hljeb će takođe biti izloženi.



DRAGAN SEVO

Mr. Sevo and his family of five returned to Bukovaca, near Bosanski Petrovac, in 2008. He is unemployed and subsists solely on his agricultural produce. His main source of income comes from selling his fruit and milk products.

In 2010 he was the beneficiary of UNHCR's buckwheat seed distribution project, implemented by Hilfswerk Austria International (HWA). He received 55 kg of buckwheat seeds for a half hectare of land and harvested approximately 1000 kg of buckwheat. From this harvest he re-planted one hectare of buckwheat and sold the rest in seeds and flour. By selling the buckwheat as flour, Dragan has been able to profit from the crop and support his family. In 2010, the largest surface of buckwheat in the country was planted in Bosanski Petrovac.

For sale at the World Refugee Day Bazaar are 1kg bags of flour. There will be a range of water mill ground flour suited to baking and for making corn flour and domestic bread. Finished goods such as cakes and bread are also available.
